

STUDENT VEHICLE PARKING POLICY

RATIONALE:

This policy outlines the expectations and procedures that students must adhere to if they wish to drive a vehicle to the College. It is based on:

- a) safety considerations
- b) the provision of duty of care
- c) the need to encourage responsible driving and behaviour

DRIVER CONDUCT ON COLLEGE PREMISES:

- Students are expected to adhere to the accepted road rules (as governed by law) and display due courtesy to fellow drivers and pedestrians
- Students need to be particularly mindful of the speed restrictions in and around College grounds, especially in the car park areas
- **Vehicles are to be parked in the student car park, located in the North-West corner, nowhere else**
- Mopeds are to be parked within the bicycle compound near the Basketball Courts. Students must alight from their moped once they leave the paved road and push their vehicle into the compound
- Students are NOT permitted to leave the College grounds in vehicles during the day without parental and College permission
- Students are NOT permitted to access their vehicle during the school day
- Students must have Good Standing to park a vehicle at the College.

CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS:

- Student drivers who wish to carry passengers to and from the College acknowledge that the College has no responsibility for such action and take full responsibility for the safety of their passengers.

IMPORTANT: Students who fail to adhere to the Student Vehicle Parking policy and drive inappropriately will be required to meet with the Principal and may be banned from parking at the College.

The Principal reserves the right to refuse the entry of a motor vehicle to the College premises should a student be seen/reported to drive in an inappropriate manner in or around the College grounds.
