The AFL Specialist Program at Ellenbrook Secondary College provides specialist coaching to develop students' skills in Australian Rules Football. The program enhances player performance while fostering leadership, umpiring, and coaching experience.

Key Features

- Fitness and Conditioning training aligned with AFL and WAFL standards.
- High-Performance Environment weekly training and game experience.

- Future Pathways VET Certificate in Sports Coaching planned for 2026.

Program Structure

- Two practical training sessions and one Health class weekly.
- Individual progress reviews and skill development.
- Complements WAFL/community football programs.

APPLICATION

To apply, students must:

- Submit an AFL Specialist Application Form by Friday 25 July 2025.
- Attend a trial on one of the following dates: 23/06/2025, 15/09/2025, or 08/12/2025 at 3:15 PM at Ellenbrook Secondary College Oval.
- If successful, students will be offered a place in the program.
- To confirm acceptance, complete a general Ellenbrook SC Enrolment Form.

Note: A football clinic will be held at the College oval in Term 3 and 4, focusing on fundamentals and basic skills. This clinic is open to Year 5 and 6 students of all abilities.

AFL Specialist Program 2026

Applications due by 25 July 2025

The Ellenbrook Secondary College Football Academy opened in 2022 with an initial intake of Year 7 students. The program provides ongoing development in the skills and attributes needed to play Australian Rules Football at the highest level.

In this program, students are given the opportunity to extend their knowledge of the rules and strategies of football. Greater emphasis is placed on all aspects of the sport, ranging from skill development to fitness requirements (draft camp testing), game strategies and coaching. There may be additional activities such as visit to the Fremantle Dockers and West Coast Eagles facilities and games, which may incur extra costs.

The program provides a well-rounded education of the sport, with two periods a week dedicated to practical sessions and one period for Health, in replacement of Physical Education.

There will be a significant focus on goal setting with regular one-on-one reviews. Students will have the opportunity to develop their skills in a high-performance environment through training and games. East Perth Football Club endorses the program in collaboration with the Western Australian Football Commission. These links will provide the students with opportunities to further develop as footballers, coaches, and umpires.

It expected that's students in this course are actively involved in Ellenbrook Secondary College's after school football teams. Students are expected to wear correct PE uniform to class and maintain school attendance above 90% to remain in the course.

Parents will be required to sign a contract to secure a place in this course and students may be removed from this program, should their behaviour or standard of participation be deemed unacceptable.
