Ellenbrook Secondary College seeks to promote a high standard of dress and personal presentation. It is a public school requirement that students comply with the Dress Code unless they have been granted an exemption. Other jackets or raincoats can be worn over the uniform on the way to College but must be removed on arrival. Any replacement pant, short or skirt items must be the same appearance as the College uniform items and Navy in colour. In particular, shorts and skirts must be worn at an appropriate length.

Uniform Changes for 2022

- Hoodies have been added to the dress code but must be navy blue, also the warrior's t-shirt has been updated with the College emblem.
- Any current uniforms that have an "ESC" are being replaced with our College emblem.
- There will be a transition period of three years. This transition period means you can still wear your current uniform until advised otherwise.

Footwear

For safety reasons, enclosed footwear must be worn at all times on College grounds.

Accessories and appearance

Students are encouraged to be sun safe and wear hats whilst in the sun. Hats are not to be worn inside the College buildings. Any garments worn under the uniform such as long sleeve tops should comply with College colours (navy or white).

Excessive make-up or jewellery is not appropriate and should be kept to a minimum. Aerosol deodorants, antiperspirants, hairspray and spray perfumes are NOT permitted to be used or brought into the College due to allergies and safety requirements. Students may bring roll-on/antiperspirants stick varieties, if required.

Exemptions to the Dress Code

All exemption request should be made in writing to the College Principal.
